
As stated in the email sent to all current students on **October 8, 2021**, UNLV is preparing for the first distribution of HEERF III funds. This email intends to keep you informed of the process for HEERF distribution. This week the eligibility review and distribution calculations will take place for those students who completed a FAFSA or Alternate Need Form for 2021-2022. The initial review shows approximately 22,900 current students have submitted a FAFSA or Alternate Need Form and are eligible for consideration.

To ensure the most timely receipt of funds, students must update their mailing address and direct deposit banking information in [MyUNLV](#) as soon as possible.

The Office of Financial Aid & Scholarships will notify students of funding for their 2021-2022 aid year in their [MyUNLV](#) account and distribute funds before **November 1, 2021**. Once funds are applied, students may use the funds to offset COVID-19 financial impacts. This would include tuition, housing, books, supplies, and fees, among other costs related to COVID-19. Students will have the option to receive a refund or to apply funds directly to a balance at UNLV.
